

# Accidental Photo of the Week:

This candid snapshot, taken in Dallas of 1963, clearly demonstrates the principle fallacy of the "Magic Bullet Theory" behind the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy. In the foreground, one can clearly see Executive Assistant to the President Jack Foley— then an Assistant Manager for DAKA Food Services— standing with his back to



the motorcade. In his left hand is the Russian-series HK sniper rifle later used for the "pacification" of Pol Pot and also Arch-Duke Ferdinand. In the background, the CIA can be clearly seen making a collect call by dialing Ø. The Magic Bullet is in the upper-most foreground, partially obscured by Jackie's hair. In the immediate background, an unconcerned Secret Service agent looks on apprehensively.
